### H.4.2 CONDITION OF WEEKLY REPORTING MEMBER BANKS IN LEADING CITIES

The condition statement of weekly reporting member banks in leading cities shows the following principal changes for the week ended September 22: a decrease of \$385 million in loans adjusted, increases of \$73 million in holdings of U. S. Government securities, \$713 million in reserves with Federal Reserve Banks, a decrease of \$2,585 million in demand deposits adjusted, an increase of \$2846 million in U. S. Government demand deposits, and a decrease of \$1,205 million in demand deposits credited to domestic commercial banks.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$258 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$91 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Government securities decreased \$264 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$190 million. Loans to sales and personal financing institutions decreased \$346 million and loans to "other" nonbank financial institutions increased \$30 million, as compared with decreases of \$243 million and \$13 million, respectively, during the similar week in 1964. Real estate loans increased \$61 million. "Other" loans increased \$14 million.

Holdings of Treasury bills by weekly reporting member banks increased \$82 million and the combined total of Treasury notes and U. S. Government bonds decreased \$9 million. "Other" securities increased \$88 million.

Demand deposits adjusted decreased in eleven districts including decreases of \$1,170 million in New York City, \$337 million in the City of Chicago, \$369 million in the San Francisco District, and \$125 million in the Cleveland District. Savings deposits increased \$143 million and "other" time deposits of individuals, partnerships, and corporations increased \$171 million.

Borrowings of weekly reporting member banks from Federal Reserve Banks increased \$680 million but borrowings from others decreased \$664 million. Loans to domestic commercial banks decreased \$471 million.
