WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

\$533 million in the week ended August 27. This reflected a decrease of \$679 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$1,054 million in U. S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$158 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$974 million while U. S. Government demand deposits increased \$481 million. Total time and savings deposits decreased \$234 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$122 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$405 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$461 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U. S. Treasury securities decreased \$68 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$40 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U. S. Treasury securities decreased \$89 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$12 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$4 million as compared with a decrease of \$334 million during the corresponding week in 1968. Real estate loans increased \$60 million, and consumer instalment loans decreased \$20 million.

Total U. S. Treasury securities held increased \$1,054 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$982 million and holdings of "other" U. S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$198 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$126 million.

Savings deposits declined \$70 million and "other" time deposits declined \$164 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, declined \$171 million.
