## WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$413 million in the week ended August 12. This reflected a decrease of \$205 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$234 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$26 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted increased \$117 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$1,003 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$566 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$75 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$13 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$306 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$64 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$141 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$362 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$41 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$146 million as compared with a decrease of \$288 million during the corresponding week in 1969. Real estate loans increased \$56 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$7 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$234 million. Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$207 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$7 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$20 million.

Savings deposits declined \$56 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$510 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$451 million.
