WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$979 million in the week ended March 24. This reflected a decrease of \$463 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$666 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$150 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted increased \$1,168 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$1,772 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$50 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$137 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$375 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$476 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$50 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$156 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$25 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$67 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$64 million as compared with an increase of \$34 million during the corresponding week in 1970. Real estate loans increased \$43 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$25 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$666 million. Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$760 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$77 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings increased \$17 million.

Savings deposits increased \$350 million and "all other" time deposits declined \$300 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, declined \$246 million.
