## WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$99 million in the week ended October 20. This reflected an increase of \$74 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$212 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$187 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$551 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$360 million. Total time and savings deposits decreased \$45 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$193 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$222 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$202 million.

Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$223 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$91 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$784 million and those involving "other securities decreased \$15 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$672 million as compared with an increase of \$183 million during the corresponding week in 1970. Real estate loans increased \$84 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$24 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$212 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$298 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$40 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$46 million.

Savings deposits increased \$77 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$32 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, declined \$241 million.
