H.4.2 WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$510 million in the week ended January 5. This reflected a decrease of \$837 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$48 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$375 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$303 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$3,425 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$58 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$298 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$522 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$181 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$100 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$373 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$240 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$53 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$366 million as compared with a decrease of \$365 million during the corresponding week in 1970. Real estate loans increased \$15 million, and consumer instalment loans decreased \$16 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$48 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$19 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$122 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings increased \$189 million.

Savings deposits increased \$448 million and "all other" time deposits declined \$390 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, declined \$639 million.
