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WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$1,136 million in the week ended January 19. This reflected a decrease of \$436 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$264 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$436 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$1,592 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$1,113 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$314 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$153 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$238 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$77 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$29 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$84 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$59 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$16 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$44 million as compared with a decreased of \$20 million during the corresponding week in 1970. Real estate loans incrased \$114 million, and consumer instalment loans decreased \$45 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$264 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$193 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$34 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$423 million.

Savings deposits increased \$192 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$122 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$9 million.
