WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$1,229 million in the week ended February 23. This reflected an increase of \$946 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$299 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$16 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$1,444 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$1,178 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$917 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$57 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$124 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$45 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$145 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$145 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$196 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$61 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$57 million as compared with a decrease of \$320 million during the corresponding week in 1971. Real estate loans increased \$79 million, and consumer instalment loans decreased \$18 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$299 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$375 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$58 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$134 million.

Savings deposits increased \$203 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$714 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$575 million.
