WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$832 million in the week ended October 4. This reflected an increase of \$1,166 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$138 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$196 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$90 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$1,325 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$294 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$410 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$780 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$241 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$135 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$62 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$597 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$8 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$182 million as compared with a decrease of \$6 million during the corresponding week in 1971. Real estate loans increased \$102 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$93 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$138 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$3 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$19 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$123 million.

Savings deposits increased \$128 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$166 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, declined \$54 million.
