WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$421 million in the week ended February 21. This reflected an increase of \$1,574 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$1,175 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$22 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$925 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$2,325 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$1,172 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$457 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$467 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$92 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$128 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$66 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$64 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$40 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$61 million as compared with an increase of \$12 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$151 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$54 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$1,175 million. Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$356 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$1,257 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings increased \$438 million.

Savings deposits increased \$23 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$1,149 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$997 million.
