WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$2,484 million in the week ended March 21. This reflected an increase of \$2,363 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$89 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$32 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$1,547 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$1,969 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$723 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$135 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,155 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans decreased \$48 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$239 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$303 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$479 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$474 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$160 million as compared with a decrease of \$188 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$153 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$44 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$89 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$180 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$212 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$303 million.

Savings deposits increased \$122 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$601 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$370 million.
