WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$823 million in the week ended March 28. This reflected a decrease of \$698 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$101 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$226 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted increased \$1,010 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$297 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$1,192 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$169 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$218 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$366 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$168 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$168 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$575 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$625 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$227 million as compared with an increase of \$56 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$120 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$128 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$101 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$286 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$38 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$223 million.

Savings deposits increased \$156 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$1,036 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$893 million.
