## WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$1,265 million in the week ended July 4. This reflected an increase of \$1,395 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$15 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$145 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$555 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$559 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$219 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$237 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$702 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$473 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$507 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities decreased \$243 million. Sales of Federal Funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$85 million and those involving "other" securities decreased \$12 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$329 million as compared with an increase of \$468 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$172 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$86 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$15 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$163 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$58 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$206 million.

Savings deposits increased \$107 million and "all other" time deposits increased \$112 million. Negotiable CD's issued in denominations of \$100,000 or more, included in the latter figure, increased \$198 million.
