WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$1,787 million in the week ended September 12. This reflected an increase of \$743 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$376 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$668 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted increased \$1,368 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$410 million. Total time and savings deposits decreased \$227 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$431 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$486 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$342 million.

Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$293 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$158 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S.

Treasury securities decreased \$104 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$7 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$6 million as compared with a decrease of \$207 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$289 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$85 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$376 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$258 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$12 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings increased \$130 million.

Savings deposits declined by \$94 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$85 million decrease). All other consumer-type time deposits (i.e. other time IPC less large negotiable CD's IPC) increased by \$42 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$469 million increase).

Included in other consumer-type time deposits are \$2,725 million outstanding of instruments in denomination of \$1,000 to less than \$100,000 and with a maturity of 4 years or more. The outstanding volume of such instruments for the previous week has been revised to \$2,553 million.
