## WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$2,955 million in the week ended December 26. This reflected an increase of \$2,779 million in loans (adjusted), an increase of \$35 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and an increase of \$141 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted increased \$6,258 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$645 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$1,018 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches decreased \$682 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$362 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$309 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$733 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$663 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$555 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$89 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$109 million as compared with an increase of \$272 million during the corresponding week in 1972. Real estate loans increased \$2 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$63 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held increased \$35 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$4 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$43 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$12 million.

Savings deposits increased by \$45 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$63 million decrease). All other consumer-type time deposits (i.e. other time IPC less large negotiable CD's IPC) increased by \$63 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$105 million increase). ¥
