WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$319 million in the week ended May 22. This reflected an increase of \$1,212 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$168 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$725 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$676 million while U.S. Government demand deposits decreased \$1,083 million. Total time and savings deposits increased \$1,931 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$329 million.

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$382 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$64 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$660 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$50 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities increased \$952 million and those involving other" securities decreased \$17 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions decreased \$158 million as compared with a decrease of \$220 million during the corresponding week in 1973. Real estate loans increased \$102 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$77 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$168 million. Holdings of Treasury bills increased \$27 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year increased \$120 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$315 million.

Savings deposits declined by \$9 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$58 million decrease). All other consumer-type time deposits (i.e. other time IPC less large negotiable CD's IPC) increased by \$248 million
