WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks increased \$1,132 million in the week ended June 19. This reflected an increase of \$1,804 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$315 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$357 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decreased \$1,551 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$4,057 million. Total time and savings deposits decreased \$441 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$85 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$1,501 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$1,317 million.

Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities increased \$68 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$75 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$1,102 million and those involving "other" securities increased \$24 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$504 million as compared with an increase of \$561 million during the corresponding week in 1973. Real estate loans increased \$235 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$124 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$315 million. Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$258 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$31 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$26 million.

Savings deposits declined by \$72 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$76 million decrease). All other consumer-type time deposits (i.e. other time IPC less large negotiable CD's IPC) increased by \$148 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$98 million increase).
