WEEKLY CONDITION REPORT OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BANKS AND DOMESTIC SUBSIDIARIES

Total loans and investments (adjusted) at large commercial banks decreased \$196 million in the week ended September 18. This reflected an increase of \$493 million in loans (adjusted), a decrease of \$653 million in U.S. Treasury security holdings and a decrease of \$36 million in holdings of "other" securities. Demand deposits adjusted decrease \$390 million while U.S. Government demand deposits increased \$2,917 million. Total time and savings deposits decreased \$408 million. Gross liabilities of banks to their foreign branches increased \$104 million.

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$658 million; during the comparable week a year ago these loans increased \$662 million. Loans to brokers and dealers for purchasing or carrying U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$513 million, and their loans for purchasing or carrying "other" securities increased \$85 million. Sales of Federal funds and purchase of securities under agreements to resell with brokers and dealers involving U.S. Treasury securities decreased \$82 million and those invloving "other" securities increased \$47 million. Loans to sales and personal finance institutions increased \$78 million as compared with an increase of \$95 million during the corresponding week in 1973. Real estate loans increased \$120 million, and consumer instalment loans increased \$47 million.

Total U.S. Treasury securities held decreased \$653 million. Holdings of Treasury bills decreased \$503 million and holdings of "other" U.S. Treasury securities maturing within 1 year decreased \$84 million. Longer term Treasury note and bond holdings decreased \$66 million.

Savings deposits declined by \$89 million (the previous week's figure was revised to a \$102 million decrease). All other consumer-type time deposits (i.e. other time IPC less large negotiable CD's IPC) increased by \$9 million
