Major asset items affected were (in billions) cash and balances due from depository institutions, \$0.4; other securities, investment account, other bonds, stocks, and securities, \$0.3; federal funds sold to commercial banks, \$0.1; real estate loans, revolving, home equity, \$0.1; real estate loans, all other, \$1.0; and all other assets, \$0.2. The major liability items affected were nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$2.2; other transaction deposits, \$0.2; borrowings, \$0.1; and the residual, \$0.2. The major memorandum item affected was time deposits in amounts of \$100,000 or more, \$0.1. A reclassification the week ending February 20, 1991 at domestically chartered banks increased commercial and industrial loans to U.S. addressees \$0.3 billion and reduced real estate loans, revolving, home equity the same amount. Reclassifications the week ending February 13, 1991 increased real estate loans, all other \$0.1 billion and reduced loans to individuals the same amount.
