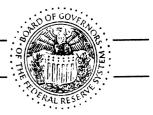

Effective March 6, 1991 real estate loans, all other increased \$0.2 billion and commercial and industrial loans to U.S. addressees and all other loans each declined \$0.1 billion as the result of a reclassification. .
