6. Includes net due from related institutions abroad for U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks having a net due from position.

- 7. For U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks includes other transaction deposits.

18. Trading account securities and other trading account assets are not available on a district basis. They are included in other assets.

NOTE: Weekly reporting banks acquired \$900 million in assets and liabilities of thrift institutions in the week ending November 20, 1991. The major asset item affected was other assets, \$800 million. The major liability item affected was nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$900 million. A reclassification at agencies and branches of foreign banks reduced commercial and industrial loans to U.S. addressees \$100 million and increased loans to nonbank financial institutions the same amount the week ending October 30, 1991. •
