The major liability items affected were: demand deposits-IPC, \$0.4 transaction deposits, \$0.3; nontranaction deposits-IPC, \$1.5; other liabilities, \$0.1; and the residual, \$0.1. The major memoranda item affected was large time deposits. than \$100,000, \$0.1.
