The major asset items affected were (in billions): U.S. government securities investment account mortgage-backed securities, \$0.7; other securities investment account other bonds, stocks, and securities, \$0.1; federal funds sold to commercial banks in the U.S., \$0.3; real estate loans, revolving, home equity, \$0.3; real estate loans, all other, \$1.4; commercial and industrial loans to U.S. addressees, \$0.2; loans to individuals, \$0.2; and other assets, \$0.3. The major liability items affected were: demand deposits-IPC, \$0.1; other transaction deposits, \$0.3; nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$2.1; borrowings, \$0.7; and other liabilities, \$0.1. A reclassification the week ending June 23, 1993 reduced real estate loans, all other \$0.2 billion and increased other securities investment account other bonds, stocks, and securities the same amount.
