The major asset items affected were (in millions): real estate loans, all other, \$500 and loans to individuals, \$100. The major liability item affected was nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$500. A reclassification at weekly reporting domestic banks the week ending July 28, 1993 increased U.S. government securities investment account maturing in over five years \$800 million and decreased other securities investment account other bonds, stocks, and securities the same amount. A reclassification at U.S. agencies and branches of foreign banks increased other securities \$200 million and decreased U.S. government securities the same amount for the week ending July 28, 1993. Another reclassification increased real estate loans \$100 million the week ending July 28, 1993 at foreign banks.
