The major asset items affected were (in billions): cash and balances due from depository institutions, \$0.2; real estate loans, all other, \$0.9; and other assets, \$0.4. The major liability items affected were: nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$0.3; borrowings, \$0.5; other liabilities, \$0.6; and the residual, \$0.2.
