- For U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks includes other transaction deposits.

- Trading account securities and other trading account assets are not available on a district basis. They are included in other assets.

NOTE: Weekly reporting domestic banks acquired \$700 million in assets and liabilities of thrift institutions in the week ending July 19, 1995. The major asset items affected were cash and balances due from depository institutions, \$600 million and other assets, \$100 million. The major liability items affected were demand deposits-IPC, \$100 million and nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$600 million. A reclassification at domestic banks the week ending July 19, 1995 reduced U.S. government securities investment account maturing in over 1 to 5 years \$300 million and increased U.S. government securities investment account maturing in over 5 years the same amount.
