- 4. For U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks includes lease financing receivables.
- 5. Includes allocated transfer risk reserve.
- 6. Includes net due from related institutions abroad for U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks having a net due from position.
- 7. For U.S. branches and agencies of foreign banks includes other transaction deposits.
- 8. Includes NOW, ATS, and telephone and pre-authorized transfer savings deposits.
- 9. Includes borrowings only from other than directly related institutions.
- 10. Includes securities sold under agreements to repurchase.
- 11. For domestically chartered banks includes federal funds purchased and securities sold under agreements to repurchase.

NOTE: Weekly reporting domestic banks acquired \$700 million in assets and liabilities of thrift institutions in the week ending January 17, 1996. The major asset items affected were U.S. government securities investment account mortgage-backed securities, \$100 million; other securities investment account other bonds, notes, and securities, \$100 million; real estate loans, all other, \$400 million; and commercial and industrial loans to U.S. addressees, \$100 million. The major liability items affected were other transaction deposits, \$100 million; nontransaction deposits-IPC, \$500 million; other liabilities for borrowed money, \$100 million; and the residual, \$100 million. The major memoranda item affected was time deposits in amounts greater than \$100,000, \$100 million.
