The seasonally ad justed money supply increased slightly in the week ending May 24. In the latest four weeks, money supply averaged about $\$ 1.5$ billion above the April level. Time deposits increased $\$ 400$ million in the latest week, and thus far in May these deposits have averaged $\$ 1.6$ billion higher than in April

NOTE Money supply cnnsists of (1) demand deposits at all commercial banks, other than those due to domestic commercial banks and the $U S$ Government, less cash items in process of collection and Federal Reserve float, (2) foreign demand balances at Federal Reserve Banks, and (3) currency outside the Treasury, the Federal Reserve and the vaults of all commercial banks Time deposits adjusted are time deposits at all commercial banks other than those due to domestic commercial banks and the US Government
