The seasonally adjusted money supply declined in the latest week, and over the latest 3 weeks money supply has averaged about the same as in August. Total time and savings deposits have increased slightly since the beginning of September, while averaging about \$400 million below the August level.

p - Preliminary

NOTE Money supply consists of (1) demand deposits at all commercial banks, other than those due to domestic commercial banks and the U S Government, less cash items in process of collection and Federal Reserve float, (2) foreign demand balances at Federal Reserve Banks, and (3) currency outside the Treasury, the Federal Reserve and the vaults of all commercial banks. Time deposits adjusted are time deposits at all commercial banks other than those due to domestic commercial banks and the U S Government.
