Money market certificates are nonnegotiable time deposits in denominations of \$10,000 or more with original maturities of exactly 26 weeks for which the maximum permissible rate of interest on new deposits at commercial banks is equal to the discount yield on the most recently issued six-month Treasury bill (auction average). For MSBs the interest rate ceiling in September and October was equal to the commercial bank rate (see p. Al0 in the Federal Reserve Bulletin).

<sup>2/</sup> Estimates for all insured commercial banks in October are based on data collected by the Federal Reserve and the FDIC from a stratified random sample of about 460 banks.
