BASED ON THE MID-POINTS OF THESE RANGES, THE OBSERVED CHANGE IN M1-B WOULD APPEAR TO BE LARGER AS A RESULT OF SHIFTS FROM ASSETS OTHER THAN DEMAND DEPOSITS TO NOW ACCOUNTS BY \$3.6 BILLION IN JANUARY, BY \$2.1 BILLION IN PEBRUARY, AND BY \$1.5 BILLION IN MARCH, IMPLYING ADJUSTED M1-B GROWTH RATES OF 1.5 PER-CENT IN JANUARY, -2.3 PERCENT IN PEBRUARY, AND 8.2 PERCENT IN MARCH. POR M1-A, ADJUSTED GROWTH RATES ARE 1.2 PERCENT IN JANUARY, -3.7 PERCENT IN FEBRUARY, AND 8.8 PERCENT IN MARCH. THESE ESTIMATES ARE SUBJECT TO REVISION AS MORE INFORMATION BECOMES AVAILABLE.
