The data, which are derived from the Federal Reserve Board's flow of funds accounts, are break-adjusted (that is, discontinuities in the data have been smoothed into the series) and month-averaged (that is, the data have been derived by averaging adjacent month-end levels). The presentation of the debt data in this release differ, therefore, from the quarterly flow of funds statistics contained in the Federal Reserve releases Z.7 and Z.1. In those releases, published levels of credit market debt are measured on a quarter-end basis and contain discontinuities.
