Revised:

1/ During March changes from a year ago reflect in part the fact that last year Easter was on April 6, while this year it will be on March 28. For this reason it is estimated that in comparison with last year allowance should be made for an increase in sales of about 1 per cent for the month of March as a whole.

* In using year ago comparisons for the weeks ending February 28 and February 21, allowance should be made for the fact that in cities observing the Washington's Birthday holiday, store closings this year occurred in the week ending February 28, whereas last year they occurred in the previous week.

** Date not available
