1/ During March and April changes from a year ago reflect in part the fact that last year Easter was on April 6 while this year it was on March 28. For this reason it is estimated that in comparison with last year allowance should be made for an increase in sales of about 1 per cent for the month of March as a whole and for a corresponding decrease for the month of April as a whole.

\* In using year ago comparisons for the weeks ending June 5 and May 29 allowance should be made for the fact that in regions observing the Memorial Day holiday store closings this year occurred in the week ending June 5 whereas last year they occurred in the previous week.
