- <sup>1/</sup> Includes required reserves against Euro-dollar borrowings and bank-related commercial paper. Reserves Available to Support Private Nonbank Deposits are required reserves for private demand deposits, total time and savings deposits, nondeposit sources subject to reserve requirements and excess reserves. Reserve aggregates reflect the change in Regulation D effective November 9, 1972, which reduced required reserves by about \$3.2 billion; and effective July 19, 1973, which increased required reserves by about \$760 million; and effective October 4, 1973, which increased required reserves \$465 million. Per cent annual rates of growth for required reserves and other reserve aggregates have been adjusted to remove the effect of these structural changes.
- <sup>2/</sup> Adjusted to include certain reserve deficiencies on which penalties can be waived for a transition period in connection with bank adaptation to Regulation J as amended effective November 9, 1972. The adjustment amounted to \$450 million from November 9 to December 27, 1972; \$279 million from December 28, 1972 to March 28, 1973; \$172 million from March 29, 1973 to June 27, 1973; \$112 million from June 28, 1973 to September 26, 1973; and \$84 million thereafter.
- <sup>3/</sup> Includes member bank deposits, bank-related commercial paper, Euro-dollar borrowings of U.S. banks, and certain nondeposit items.
- <sup>4/</sup> On November 28, bank-related commercial paper amounted to \$4,966 million.
