Reserves Available to Support Private Nonbank Deposits are required reserves for private demand deposits, total time and savings deposits, nondeposit sources subject to reserve requirements and excess reserves. Reserve aggregates reflect changes in Regulation D. Per cent annual rates of growth for required reserves and other reserve aggregates have been adjusted to remove the effect of these structural changes.
- 2/ Adjusted to include certain reserve deficiencies on which penalties can be waived for a transition period in connection with bank adaptation to \$84 million from September 27, 1973 to December 26, 1973; \$67 million from December 27, 1973 to March 27, 1974; and \$58 million thereafter.
- 3/ Includes member bank deposits, bank-related commercial paper, Euro-dollar borrowings of U.S. banks, and certain nondeposit items.
