required reserves for (1) private demand deposits, (2) total time and savings deposits, and (3) nondeposit sources of funds, plus excess reserves. Reserve aggregates reflect changes in Regulation D. Fer cent annual rates of growth for required reserves and other reserve aggregates have been adjusted to remove the effect of these structual changes. Beginning December 12, 1974, reserve aggregates were reduced by about \$710 million, RPD by \$650 million. Includes member bank deposits, loans sold to bank-related institutions, Euro-dollar borrowings of U. S. banks, and certain nondeposit items.

On Jan. 8, 1975 bank-related commercial paper amounted to 8,638 million. Average of range of offering rates of negotiable certificates or deposit with three month maturity in secondary market,
