Reserves Available to Support Private Nonbank Deposits are required reserves for private demand deposits, total time and savings deposits, nondeposit sources subject to reserve requirements and excess reserves. Reserve aggregates reflect changes in Regulation D. Per cent annual rates of growth for required reserves and other reserve aggregates have been adjusted to remove the effect of these structural changes.
 - ^{2/} Includes member bank deposits, loans sold to bank-related institutions, Euro-dollar borrowings of U.S. banks, and certain nondeposit items.
 - ^{3/} On March 31, 1976 bank-related commercial paper amounted to \$8420 million.
 - ^{4/} Average of range of offering rates of negotiable certificates of deposit with three month maturity in secondary market.
 - ^{5/} Posted rates = the annual interest rates most often quoted on new offerings of negotiable certificates of deposit in denominations of \$100,000 or more.
