CHANGES IN STATE BANK MEMBERSHIP

Date effective

Consolidation, Absorptions, and Establishments of Branches

- 2 Bank of the Manhattan Company, New York, New York, a State member, absorbed Bronx County Trust Company, New York, New York, also a State member. The former main office and branches of the absorbed bank will be operated as branches of the continuing bank. 3-21-55
- 2 Community Trust Company, Bloomfield, New Jersey, a State member, was absorbed by the National Newark and Essex Banking Company, Newark, New Jersey. A branch was established in the former location of the absorbed bank. 3-21-55
- 3 East Petersburg State Bank, East Petersburg, Pennsylvania, a State member, and The Fulton National Bank, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, consolidated under the charter and title of the latter bank. A branch was established in the former location of East Petersburg State Bank. 3-25-55

Establishment of State Member Branch

- 4 Bank of Commerce, Lexington, Kentucky, ~~has~~ established a branch at 1974 Harrodsburg Road, to be known as Lafayette Branch. 3-21-55
