Merger, Absorptions, Consolidation and
Establishment of Branches

- 1 Riverside Trust Company, Hartford, Connecticut, a State member, and Bankers Trust Company, Essex, Connecticut, an insured nonmember, merged under charter and title of Riverside Trust Company. A branch was established in the former location of Bankers Trust Company. 7-17-58
- 1 Depositors Trust Company, Augusta, Maine, a State member, absorbed Knox County Trust Company, Rockland, Maine, an insured nonmember. A branch was established in the former location of the absorbed bank. 7-21-58
- 7 Central State Bank, Elkader, Iowa, a State member, absorbed Farmers State Bank, St. Olaf, Iowa, an insured nonmember. A branch was established in the former location of the absorbed bank. 8-9-58
- 10 The International Trust Company, Denver, Colorado, a State member, and The First National Bank of Denver, Denver, Colorado, consolidated under charter and title of The First National Bank of Denver, Denver, Colorado. 8-11-58

Change in title and location

- 12 Pico Citizens Banks, Pico, California, has changed its title and address to Bank of Pico Rivera, Pico Rivera, California, This change is due to the merger of the unincorporated areas of Pico and Rivera into the incorporated area of Pico Rivera.
