Merger, Conversion and Establishment of Branches

- 3 Dauphin Deposit Trust Company, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, a State member, and Camp Curtin Trust Company, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, an insured nonmember, merged under charter and title of Dauphin Deposit Trust Company. The former main office and branches of Camp Curtin Trust Company will be operated as branches by the continuing bank. 7-17-61
- 10 First State Bank of Westminster, Westminster, Colorado, a State member, has converted into a national bank under title of First National Bank, Westminster. 7-20-61
