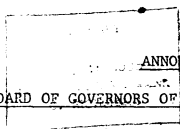

Withdrawal From Federal Reserve Membership

7 First Bank and Trust Company of Clay County, 7-1-69
Indiana, Brazil, Indiana.

Mergers, Absorption, and Establishment of Branches

5 Anson Bank and Trust Company, Wadesboro, North 7-1-69
Carolina, a State member bank, and American
Bank & Trust Company, Monroe, North Carolina,
an insured nonmember bank, merged under charter
and title of latter bank. The head office and
branches of Anson Bank and Trust Company will be
operated as branches by the continuing bank.

7 Citizens State Bank, Jamestown, Indiana, a State 7-1-69
member bank, was absorbed by Boone County State
Bank, Lebanon, Indiana, an insured nonmember bank.
A branch was established in the former location
of Citizens State Bank.

7 Peoples State Bank of Bronson, Bronson, Michigan, 7-1-69
a State member bank, and The First National Bank
of Quincy, Quincy, Michigan, merged under charter
of The First National Bank of Quincy, and title
of First National Bank of Quincy. A branch was
established in the former location of Peoples
State Bank of Bronson.

12 Valley Bank of Nevada, Reno, Nevada, and Bank of 7-1-69
Las Vegas, Las Vegas, Nevada, both State member
banks, merged under charter of latter bank and title
of Valley Bank of Nevada, Las Vegas, Nevada.
The head office and branches of Valley Bank of
Nevada, Reno, Nevada, will be operated as
branches by the continuing bank.
