2/ The figures reported through April 1943 include interbank demand deposits. To give some idea of the effect of the exclusion of such deposits thereafter the amount of interbank deposits was reported separately during the second half of that month; at country banks in places of 15,000 population and over, the amount reported was \$863,590,000, and at country banks in places of less than 15,000 population it was \$216,001,000.
