<sup>2</sup>/ The figures reported through April 1943 include interbank demand deposits. To give some idea of the effect of the exclusion of such deposits there- after the amount of interbank deposits was reported separately during the second half of that month; at country banks in places of 15,000 population and over, the amount reported was \$863,590,000, and at country banks in places of less than 15,000 population it was \$216,001,000.
