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PRODUCTIVITY AND COSTS

Private Business, Nonfarm Business, and Manufacturing Sectors,
Fourth Quarter 1977
(and annual averages for 1977)

Productivity in the private business sector in the fourth quarter of 1977 increased 1.4 percent (at an annual rate), according to preliminary measures released today by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor. This increase reflected a 4.8 percent rise in output and a 3.4 percent increase in hours of all persons. In the third quarter, productivity rose 5.4 percent on the strength of a 5.2 percent increase in output coupled with a 0.2 percent decline in hours.

In the nonfarm business sector, productivity increased 1.2 percent in the fourth quarter, as output rose 4.5 percent and hours increased 3.2 percent (at annual rates). In the third quarter, productivity increased 3.8 percent, as output advanced 4.8 percent and hours edged 0.9 percent higher.

The statistical series included in this press release reflect the use of new seasonal factors in BLS estimates of employment and average weekly hours. These revisions apply to data from 1972 forward. The effect of the new data is most apparent in the measures of quarterly change at compound annual rate; otherwise the effect of the new seasonal factors is minimal. NOTE: All of the data affected by the new factors are contained in this press release.

In manufacturing, productivity declined 0.5 percent, as output rose 3.0 percent while hours of all persons increased 3.5 percent. In the third quarter, productivity increased 5.2 percent, output rose 5.6 percent, and hours increased 0.4 percent. The fourth quarter productivity decline was the first drop in a year.

Revised third quarter measures for the nonfinancial corporate sector were also released today (table 3). Fourth quarter measures are summarized in table A; details are given in tables 1-6.

Private Business Sector

Productivity increased 1.4 percent in the private business sector in the fourth quarter of 1977, as output rose 4.8 percent and hours of all persons increased 3.4 percent. Output grew at progressively slower rates in each quarter of 1977, and the 4.8 percent fourth quarter increase was the smallest since the fourth quarter of 1976. Movements in hours did not show a similar pattern during the year; the fourth quarter increase of 3.4 percent followed a 0.2 percent decline during the third quarter.

Hourly compensation--which includes the hourly cost of wages and salaries, supplements, and employer contributions to Social Security and other employee benefit plans--increased 7.0 percent in the fourth quarter. In the third quarter, hourly compensation rose 8.5 percent. Real hourly compensation--after adjusting for changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI)--increased 2.6 percent (at an annual rate) in the fourth quarter. In the preceding quarter, the increase was 3.0 percent.

Unit labor cost, which is influenced by changes in output per hour and compensation per hour, rose 5.6 percent in the fourth quarter, compared with a 2.9 percent rise during the third quarter. The faster rate of increase in the fourth quarter reflected the slowing of the rate of increase in productivity, since hourly compensation grew less than in the third quarter.

The implicit price deflator, which reflects the combined effects of changes in unit labor cost and unit nonlabor payments, increased 5.5 percent in the fourth quarter, compared with a 5.2 percent increase in the third quarter.

Comparing the fourth quarter of 1977 with the fourth quarter of 1976, productivity increased 2.9 percent, output rose 7.0 percent, and hours of all persons increased 4.0 percent. Hourly compensation rose 8.4 percent over the year earlier level, while real hourly compensation increased 1.7 percent. Unit labor cost increased 5.3 percent, and the implicit price deflator went up 5.6 percent.

Nonfarm Business Sector

Productivity increased 1.2 percent in the nonfarm business sector in the fourth quarter of 1977, reflecting rises of 4.5 percent and 3.2 percent in output and hours, respectively, (at annual rates). In the third quarter, productivity increased 3.8 percent as output rose 4.3 percent and hours increased 0.9 percent. The moderation of the rate of growth of productivity mainly reflected the faster increase in hours of all persons, since output grew at similar rates in both quarters.

Compensation per hour rose 7.5 percent in the nonfarm business sector in the fourth quarter, matching the third quarter increase; real hourly compensation rose 3.1 percent compared with a 2.1 percent rise in the third quarter. Unit labor cost rose 6.1 percent and the implicit price deflator went up 4.8 percent in the fourth quarter. In the third quarter, the movements were 3.5 percent and 7.0 percent, respectively.

Manufacturing Sectors

Productivity declined 0.5 percent in the fourth quarter in manufacturing, reflecting a 3.0 percent increase in output coupled with a 3.5 percent rise in hours. This was the first drop in manufacturing productivity since the fourth quarter of 1976. In the third quarter, productivity increased 5.2 percent as output rose 5.6 percent and hours increased 0.4 percent. Hourly compensation rose 8.0 percent (compared with a 6.9 percent rise in the third quarter), while real hourly compensation increased 3.6 percent (compared with a 1.5 percent rise in the third quarter). Unit labor cost rose 8.6 percent, a significant increase from the 1.6 percent rise in the third quarter.

In durables, productivity declined 1.9 percent, the second quarterly drop this year. Output was up 3.0 percent, but hours increased 5.0 percent. Partly owing to the productivity decline, unit labor cost rose 10.4 percent; hourly compensation increased 8.3 percent, and real hourly compensation rose 3.9 percent.

In nondurables, productivity increased 1.6 percent in the fourth quarter, reflecting increases of 3.0 percent and 1.4 percent in output and hours, respectively. Hourly compensation grew 7.0 percent, and unit labor cost increased 5.4 percent.

Annual Review of Productivity and Costs: 1977

Productivity growth in the private business sector in 1977 did not match the pace of 1976. The 2.4 percent increase in 1977 reflected a 6.0 percent increase in output and a 3.6 percent rise in hours. During 1976, productivity rose 4.2 percent. Although output growth was comparable in both years (up 7.0 percent in 1976 and 6.0 percent in 1977), growth of hours of all persons accelerated during 1977. The increase in hours was the largest since 1973.

The slowing of the rate of growth of productivity in 1977 was also evident in the increase in unit labor cost. The 6.1 percent rise in 1977 was larger than the 4.7 percent increase in 1976, partly owing to the slowing of productivity growth; hourly compensation grew more slowly in 1977 than in 1976. Real hourly compensation increased 2.1 percent in 1977, compared with a 3.1 percent rise in 1976. The implicit price deflator increased 5.1 percent in 1977 and 4.8 percent in 1976.

In the nonfarm business sector, productivity increased 2.0 percent in 1977, compared with a 4.1 percent rise in 1976. Output grew 5.9 percent, and hours of all persons increased 3.8 percent. Hourly compensation rose 8.5 percent, and unit labor cost increased 6.4 percent. The implicit price deflator went up 5.5 percent in 1977.

In manufacturing, productivity increased 2.2 percent, reflecting a 1.5 percent increase in durables and a 3.1 percent rise in nondurables. Output increased 5.8 percent in the sector as a whole over 1976 levels, and hours of all persons were 3.6 percent higher. Hours in the manufacturing sector remained somewhat lower than in 1974 and at nearly the same level as in 1967.

The durable goods producing sector is typically the most sensitive to cyclical fluctuations. Productivity increased 1.5 percent in 1977, compared with a 7.2 percent increase in 1976. Output increased about half as much as in 1976 (up 6.3 percent in 1977, 12.1 percent in 1976), but hours grew somewhat faster in 1977 (4.8 percent versus 4.5 percent in 1976). Hourly compensation rose 8.5 percent, and unit labor cost increased 6.9 percent. In 1976, these increases were 8.9 percent and 1.5 percent, respectively.

In nondurables, productivity increased 3.1 percent in 1977, compared with a 6.1 percent rise in 1976. Output grew 5.1 percent (compared with a 10.8 percent rise in 1976), and hours of all persons increased 1.9 percent (compared with a 4.4 percent rise in 1976). Hourly compensation increased 8.9 percent and unit labor cost rose 5.6 percent. Real hourly compensation increased 2.3 percent.

Revisions in Seasonal Factors

The Bureau of Labor Statistics recently introduced new seasonal factors for use in adjusting employment and average weekly hours measures. Since productivity and cost series are based on measures which are affected by these regular revisions, changes will occur in the measures for 1972 and later quarters. The effect of the new data can most clearly be seen in the quarterly changes at compound annual rate; table B illustrates the effect for 1977 in the private business sector. The historical series affected by the revisions are contained in the appendix tables of this press release.

Nonfinancial Corporations

The Bureau of Labor Statistics also released revised third quarter measures of productivity and costs for the nonfinancial corporate sector. This sector, which includes all corporations doing business in the United States with the exception of banks, stock and commodity brokers, and finance and insurance companies, showed a 4.4 percent increase in productivity in the third quarter, as output rose 5.0 percent and hours of all employees increased 0.6 percent. Previously, these increases had been reported at 3.8 percent in productivity and 3.9 percent and 0.1 percent in output and hours, respectively.

QUARTER AT ANNUAL RATE)




CHART 2. PRODUCTIVITY, HOURLY

QUARTER AT ANNUAL RATE)




CHART 3. PRODUCTIVITY, HOURLY

QUARTER A YEAR AGO)



